Jesus and Zacchaeus

A chancel drama based on Luke 19:1-10

Two By-Standers are standing between the choir pews and the front pews. A step-ladder is in front of the organ. In front of the ladder are Zacchaeus and members of the Crowd. Jesus and a Disciple are in the narthex, just beyond the doorway to the sanctuary.

By-Stander #1 "Wow, I can't wait to see Jesus. Pretty cool that this famous — and controversial — rabbi comes all the way down here to Jericho to visit us."

By-Stander #2 "Yeah, this is a big deal for our town. People have been talking about him and wondering if he'll *do* something *dramatic* — you know, change someone's life by healing him. Or her."

By-Stander #1 [Points to Zacchaeus] "Well, that Zacchaeus is one guy even Jesus couldn't change. It's bad enough that he, a Jew like all of us, is collaborating with our Roman conquerors by collecting taxes for them, but everyone in town knows he collects 'a little extra' [rubs her fingers together] on top of what the Romans want — 'a little extra' just for him. [Other By-Stander nods.] Look how rich he's gotten. No way that's just on a civil service salary."

[Jesus starts to walk into the nave and up the outside aisle on the organ side, accompanied by his disciple. Zacchaeus tries to see him over the crowd but can't.]

By-Stander #2 "Look, the little shorty can't see Jesus over the crowd! Well, no way Jesus is going to pay any attention to him *even* if Zacchaeus climbed that sycamore tree and waved at Jesus."

[Zacchaeus climbs two steps up the ladder and waves at Jesus.] "Well, does that rip-off artist have gall or what."

Crowd "Hurrah for Jesus!"

<u>Disciple</u> [*Tugs Jesus' robe and leans towards him.*] "Lord, just so you know, see that short guy up in the tree? That's Zacchaeus, the *tax collector* for the *Romans*, and I hear he's the most *corrupt* person in all of Jericho. Definitely someone you don't want to have anything to do with."

<u>Jesus</u> [Smiles to his disciple, then turns and addresses Zacchaeus.] "Zacchaeus, hurry and come down, for I must stay at your house today."

Crowd, By-Standers and Disciple "WHAT??!!"

[Zacchaeus eagerly climbs down.]

By-Stander #1 "He has gone to be the guest of one who is a *sinner!*"

<u>Crowd, By-Standers and Disciple</u> "Grumble, grumble, grumble." [*Then they stop.*]

Zacchaeus [Meets Jesus. Speaks loudly.] "Look, half of my possessions, LORD, I will give to the poor; and if I have defrauded anyone of anything, I will pay back four times as much."

Crowd, By-Standers and Disciple "GASP!"

By-Stander #1 "WOW! Are you kidding me? Now that's a miracle. Now let me see, Zacchaeus would owe me..." [Starts counting on her fingers.]

By-Stander #2 "I wouldn't believe it unless I were listening with my own ears. I guess there are lots of different ways Jesus can change someone's life."

<u>Jesus</u> [Looks fondly at Zacchaeus.] "Today salvation has come to this house, because he too is a son of Abraham. For the Son of Man came to seek out and to save the lost."

Zacchaeus "I once was lost, but now I'm found, LORD. As your follower, I will always have *more than enough*."

[Jesus and Zacchaeus walk off-stage to the room behind the organ.] [Entire cast takes center stage and bows, then returns to their seats.]
